Door Prize: As an exhibitor, each business must provide at least one prize worth \$25 or more to be raffled at your booth by your business. The exhibitor is responsible for supplying everything needed for the raffle (i.e. entry forms, pens, fishbowl, etc.). The exhibitor draws a winner(s) at a time of his or her choosing and contacts the winner. Entry forms can be used for business leads after the event.

EXHIBITOR RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **Exhibit Ownership:** Each booth is rented by and assigned to one business. Exhibitors are not permitted to sublet their booth or share their space with another business owner.
2. **Expo Times:** The Waynesville Business Expo will be held on Saturday, March 28 from 9 AM to 1 PM at the Waynesville Junior High School Main Gym & Cafeteria. All exhibitors shall be present and operate their booth from 9 AM to 1 PM. This contract specifically prohibits the exhibitor from dismantling or removing items from this exhibit before 1 PM.
3. **Set Up Times:** Exhibitors can set up on Friday, March 27th 3:30-5:00pm or Saturday, March 28th, beginning at 7:00 AM. On Saturday, March 28, doors will open to exhibitors at 9 AM for guests. Setup time selection must be made at checkout process.
4. **Exhibit must be attractive and non-offensive.** Please note the following conditions:
 1. Direct sales are allowed only within the confines of your booth. No wandering sales.
 2. Booths with electricity are assigned one (1) socket only. Exhibitors may use only one (1) splitter. Exhibitor must provide own extension cord.
 3. Electricity may not be shared with other booths.
 4. No hand-made signs are allowed. Signage must look professional.
 5. Displays must be confined to the booth and may not infringe on your neighbors. This includes lighting and audio/visual elements as well.
 6. All booths and materials must conform to fire code regulations.
 7. Exhibits may not use water or fire or any other materials that could damage flooring.
 8. No pets allowed in the building.
5. **Wayne Local Schools regulations must be followed:** Please do not bring any alcohol, tobacco products, drugs, weapons, or any other items deemed unsuitable.
6. **End of Event:** Expo ends at 1PM. This contract strictly prohibits dismantling booths before 1 PM. All items must be completely removed by 3PM. Material left behind will be discarded.
7. **Cancellation by Exhibitor:** Refunds will not be given due to Exhibitor cancellation. Please note: Sponsorship dollars are non-refundable.
8. **Cancellation by the Chamber:** Should the Chamber need to cancel the Event for any reason beyond its control, such as but not limited to acts of God, fires, tornados, inclement weather, and/or acts of terrorism, the Chamber will not be held financially liable to the exhibitor.

Waynesville Area Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to:

1. Remove any exhibit or part thereof that is not suitable for the family friendly event. No refunds will be given.
